

BLOOD DRIVE - FEB. 20, 2:30-7:30 PM



ASH WEDNESDAY: PANCAKES & WORSHIP





HYMN SING SUNDAY, MARCH 26



Brian is fine with Youth Group taking chairs from the old office and using them in the Loft at the North Church. Pastor Jason shared that he has a sound system in place for the North Church and will work on video options. It was also mentioned that there is a need to replace tables in the classrooms of the North Church and there will be a need for tables and chairs in the sanctuary.

<u>Mission</u> – The North Church is cleared out. They helped about 25 families at Christmas and continue with the monthly food pantry.
