An overview of issues at the April 14 Parish Council meeting:



Tentative dates for VBS 2016 are Tuesday, May 31 through Thursday, June 2. Teen Bibles will be presented to high school seniors on May 1. The first Parents and Preschoolers was attended by about 7 youth plus adults. Worship in the Park is set for June 12 at 10 AM; Potluck to follow at 11:30. Property Committee: A total building surge protector has been installed at the South Church. THANK YOU KIM YODER for donating your time!! Jason and others are working to eliminate the buzz in the sound system. Tim Elliott is aware the Calls are moving the end of May and that we will need new tenants in the parsonage. Mission Committee – sales at April sale were not good. Will try again in May. Kathi received money from HACAP to expand the educational portion of the food pantry. SPPRC needs to meet soon to complete Pastor Jason's annual evaluation. Adapt to Thrive trend is to make church the community hub of Ainsworth. New Business: Plans are to purchase sod and fill dirt for around the South Church. A professional pest control company will begin spraying regularly at the parsonage. Grants: If the Parish Council chooses to seek funding from the Riverboat Foundation, they will seek approval from the congregation for a period of 2 years to cover mini and regular grants. All grants or monies being sought for the church and its projects should be brought to Parish Council before final submission. RAGBRAI: Wayne Freyenberger will chair a fund raising committee to host a food booth. Possibly serve brownies and/or fruit cobbler with ice cream. Fall Festival: Use monies earned at RAGBRAI to host a community wide fall festival in 2016 held in early September. Next meeting May 12 at 7 PM.


