





BUT, it MUST be completed by July 1. Mission – During November they served 62 people from 20 families through the food pantry. They all received either a turkey or a ham for Thanksgiving. Ann and Wayne Freyenberger and Larry and Kathi Bean helped clean and organize the mission room in the North Church getting ready for Christmas Giving. Kathi took cookies and a thank you to TKD. In December, the Mission Committee served 18 families (51 people). For Christmas giving there were 12 families (43 people) who received food, clothing, and gifts. Small gifts were supplied to 18 people at Townview Village, plus small gifts to 5 or 6 other adults who came to the community room to see a 2nd grade class from

Highland perform. Small gifts were also given to the 22 Highland students. This helped to clean out the odds and ends from the mission room.

**Old Business**: Congregation vote to eliminate the Memorial and Finance Committees was approved. All reports and information in the Charge Conference packet was approved by the congregation and accepted at the December 10 Charge Conference. Jan has signed documents to be the second signature if needed. AmySara's employment ended December 31, 2017. Nick and Sam have been working since September and they will receive mileage.


**New Business**: New officers and committee liaisons were determined. It was agreed to continue meeting the 2nd Monday of the month at 7 PM.
