

week. The Harvest Meal will be November 7 and the Youth Christmas Program will be December 9 during 10:30 AM worship. Membership/Nurture – Janet has continued to send cards as needed. Worship - Plans for Advent and Veterans Day are in process. They are also working on a special Women's night out event that may be held quarterly. The Bethel Presbyterian Church north of town donated their communion service ware to us. **Property** – We will try to use just one internet source to serve both churches.
