STAYING CONNECTED W/ACC USING REMIND



If you have the option to send and receive text messages, please sign up for our free text message service called "Remind." Here are the instructions:

Using your cell phone, start a new text message. Type this number in as the "contact or recipient": **81010.** In the "message" portion of the text enter: **@ainsworthc** Click send. You will then get a message back saying you have joined Ainsworth Church. Your title will be 'student/parent'. This option allows Pastor Jason to send you a short message notifying you of worship and other church related notices.

We highly encourage you to sign up for this if at all possible.



An overview of reports and issues discussed at the March meeting. **Pastor Jason** shared January and February reports. He summarized a meeting with the Bishop that outlined a "Circuit Rider" concept that will be used in the coming year for district staff. Youth Group is using materials from City Point and it seems to be going pretty well. **Christian Education**: Kids'

Club Spring Session report – about 15 youth are participating. Ash Wednesday Pancake



Supper and worship service was attended by over 50 persons including ACC and UCC plus Kids' Club. Membership/Nurture: Transferred Rachel Kaufman Berner to North Liberty First UMC. Flowers sent to Karen Megchelsen Family following death of her mother and flowers also sent to Rita Anderson Family following the death of her father. Worship: Worship Assistants have been secured for Sunday's in Lent. Property: They are working on doors, steps, and a leak in the ceiling at the south entrance of the South Church. Jason will discuss a proposal from the parsonage tenant concerning the garage with the property committee. They have installed the handicapped bars in the women's restroom at the South Church. Mission: The Food Pantry served 8 families representing 26 people in January. In February, 6 families were served representing 28 people. Through Highland Outreach, 13 people were served lunch in February. Old Business: Jason has secured Scott Johnson for Pulpit Supply on Sunday, March 15, 2020 (family vacation). No one from UCC will be attending Annual Conference. Jason may not be attending either. Sherri is working on Fund Balance Report that was due March 1. New Business: Erin moved and Shalyn seconded the motion to baptize Delilah Jo-Anne Schultz on Sunday, April 5, 2020. Approved. Jan shared copies of the statistical reports for review, Ideas for Sandy Stout memorial money: Jason is interested in updating the altar area and installing a screen at the back of the church for him to see what the congregation is seeing at the front of the church. Jan thanked them for the thumb drive of the Methodist Hymnal. Jan will send a 'thank you' letter to Washington County Ambulance Service for the gift of an AED machine. Plans are to house it at the South Church. The next regular meeting of PC will be on Monday, April 13 at 7 PM.
