PARISH COUNCIL HIGHLIGHTS

Highlights of the January meeting: **Treasurer's Report**: Colleen noted that there was nothing unusual this month in the general balance sheet. In reviewing bills, she noted that amounts have changed due to not deducting for Jason's insurance. She also noted that Kitch Shatzer has been paid for moderator expenses. **Pastor's Report:** For December and January, Jason reported no

premarital counseling, but did report other counseling as three (3). There were no baptisms. Committee Reports: Worship: Nothing to report. Christian Education: Kids' Club started the Spring session on January 10th. They will have the ACC Kid's Club Pancake Supper on February 14th at 6pm in the Fellowship Hall. Youth are attending Youth Group at Bethel. Membership/Nurture: Janet Rees sent a card to the Rice Family. Myron Rees reported that the committee is active on sending out get well/sympathy card to non-active members. Property: Alliant Energy sent a letter regarding in improperly coated natural gas pipe entering the North Church's outer wall, and it is the church's responsibility to take care of this. Teri Russell will be calling Armstrong Heating and Air Conditioning to have this addressed. Mission: – In December the Mission Committee served 10 families representing 36 individuals. Five families (14 people) received Christmas presents from the Mission Committee. We received donations from

four families from the church, one family not from church and Sacha Club. **SPPRC:** The pastor's salary was approved. Nominating Committee: Nothing to report. New Business: The need to hire someone for snow and ice removal at the churches was discussed and Jason suggested that we hire high school student, Eli Cavin. After much discussion, it was decided to hire him at a rate of \$20/HR. It was also decided on a maximum of up to 2 hours per time, but not less than a total of \$20.00. He is to report his hours to Colleen so she can issue a check. Arthur will remove snow from the parking area and will charge when it is done. Jason needs to complete two courses for his continuing education. He also asked if the church would consider paying \$500.00 for "Play Attention", with UCC paying \$500.00 for the other half (he is presenting it to them at their next Session meeting on January 20, 2024. This is a device that he would wear that helps him stay focused due to his learning disability (ADD). Myron wants to know if it works when he is done. Colleen asked to be notified if UCC approves. Session approved the expense, if UCC approves also. Tenant: She is current as of the end of December and has paid half of the rent for January. Cancellation of church services due to inclement weather was discussed and it was decided that Jason will contact Myron for approval and then contact Teri in order to notify the congregation via radio, TV and the Calling Tree. Dennis Bean was installed as an Elder by Kitch. Session discussed adding Teri Russell as a signer and to be able to write checks for the church in Colleen's absence. This was approved. Liaisons for church committees was addressed and the following individuals and committees were decided upon: Committee: Steve Graves; Christian Education: Jacob Hartzler; Mission Committee: Dennis Bean; Membership Committee: Myron Rees; Memorial Committee: Oscar Steele; Property Committee: Jason Collier; SPPRC Committee: Betty Bean.
